SUBJ: CLARIFICATION OF SWAN'S ISLAND POLICY (2nd Revision)

1. Anyone coming to Swan's Island, **other** than from Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont, Connecticut, New York and New Jersey must have evidence of a negative COVID-19 test taken 72 hours prior to arrival or quarantine in place for 14 days. Although the testing is not required for visitors from the above states, it is still encouraged by the Town of Swan's Island to test prior to arrival.
2. Contact the Town Office upon arrival with results of testing. The State Certificate of Compliance must be filled out and signed. Copies of the Certificate are available at the Town Office and the form has also been posted on the [swanisland.org](http://swanisland.org) web site and the Town Office Face book Page. If quarantine is required, the following is applicable:


Self Quarantine


- (1) Stay on your property during the length of the quarantine and monitor your temperature. Practice social distancing at all times. Have a mask at all times to use as necessary. Swan's Island policy has been modified to allow walking on roads and hiking on trails as social distancing is maintained. Have a mask with you at all times. This is a deviation from State requirements to allow for exercise.
- (2) Arrive with enough food and supplies for the 14-day period. If you need something from the store, call TIMS (526-4043) and place an order. You will need to pay by credit card. Arrangements will have to be made for pickup of your order.


